1.	Is there any flexibility to change /modify the route?	The alignment of routes, location of stops, may from time to time, be changed by Employer. Please refer to Clause 28.1 of the Agreement and Clause 1.9.2 of Operational Specification Schedule. (No Change Required)
2.	Can advertisement be done on buses and shelters?	Advertisement shall be allowed inside and on the back of the buses with the locations approved from the Employer. Please refer to Clause 18 of the Agreement and Clause 1.8 of the Operational Specification Schedule. (No Change Required)
3.	Is there any flexibility of allowing families too on Pink Buses?	No, currently this service is only for females. There's no provision of families. Please refer to Clause 8.2 of the Agreement. (No Change is Required)
4.	Is there any consideration of no payments for first six months?	No. There's no such provision in current RFP. (No Change is Required)
5.	Is Mardan a three years contract?	No, Mardan contract is one year. There was a typo error in Clause 2.2.2. of the Agreement for Mardan. (Change is made in Clause 2.2.2 of the Agreement for Mardan to reflect one year contract instead of three years contract.
