Bid Solicitation Document
“Supply, Delivery and Installation of IT Equipment to TransPeshawar”

1. The TransPeshawar (The Urban Mobility Company) (hereinafter called “the Purchaser”) hereby requests eligible bidders to submit price quotation for **Supply, Delivery and installation of Interactive Flat Panel to TransPeshawar**. Following is the qualification/eligibility requirements to be fulfilled by the bidder. The supporting document shall be attached accordingly.

- (i) Original Equipment Manufacturer or Authorized Dealer, or reseller/retail partner authorized by/registered with the authorized dealers/OEM;
- (ii) Registered with FBR for sales and income tax and reflected on Active Tax Payer List (ATL);
- (iii) Attached Brochures, catalogue(s) or other printed material or pertinent information (in English language) of the quoted item/brand.
- (iv) Submission of requisite Bid Security in accordance with Bid Solicitation Document.

To assist you in the preparation of your bid price we enclose the necessary technical specifications/requirements and quantity as “**Technical Specifications and Standards of Performance**” (Appendix-I)

2. You must quote for all the items under this request. Bids will be evaluated for all items collectively and the contract awarded to the qualified bidder offering the lowest evaluated total cost of all the items.

3. You shall submit one original set of documents including Bid Price on Form of Bid in an envelope clearly marked “Original”. In addition, you shall also submit one copy of bid marked as “COPY”. In case of any discrepancy between the Original and Copy, the original shall prevail. The “original” and “copy” shall be sealed in a single outer envelope delivered to the following address:

4. You shall submit only one bid for the given items alternative bids shall not be entertained. Your bid must be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by you or your authorized representative. Without a signature in your Form of Bid, your bid shall be considered non-responsive.

5. Your bid should be submitted as per the following instructions and in accordance with the attached form of Contract. The attached Terms and Conditions of Supply is an integral part of the Contract:

- i. PRICES: The prices shall be quoted for supply and delivery of given items at office of TransPeshawar. Prices shall be quoted in PKR. Price shall remain firm and fix during currency of the contract.
- ii. BID SECURITY: Bid security shall be submitted to the amount of two (2%) of the total bid amount in shape of CDR from scheduled bank of Pakistan in the name of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) TransPeshawar. The bid security shall be provided from the account of bidder submitting the bid. A bid not accompanied by compliant bid security shall be rejected as non-responsive;
 - (a) The requisite bid security shall remain valid for a period of Twenty-Eight (28) days beyond the original validity period of the bids;
 - (b) Bid Security of the unsuccessful bidders shall be released as promptly as possible upon the successful Bidder’s furnishing of the performance security;
 - (c) The bid security of successful bidder shall be returned once the successful bidder has signed the contract agreement and furnished the required performance security.
 - (d) The Bid security may be forfeited if:
 - i. a bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity.

- ii. In the case of a successful bidder, if he fails to:
 - accept the correction of his Bid Price, pursuant to Para below; or
 - Furnish the Performance security in accordance with Para below;
 - Sign the contract agreement, in accordance with Para below
 - iii. EVALUATION OF BIDS: Offers meeting the terms and conditions, conformance to the technical specifications, and standards of performance and meeting eligibility and/ or qualification requirements stipulated in Bid solicitation document shall be determined as substantially responsive and shall be evaluated by comparison of their prices. An offer is not substantially responsive if it contains material omissions, deviations or reservations to the terms, conditions, eligibility and/ or qualification requirements and technical specifications and standards of performance provided for in Bid Solicitation Document, and it will not be considered further. The bidder not complying the required technical specifications (**Appendix-I**) of the product/good and other requirements of bid solicitation document will be disqualified. In evaluating the bids, the Purchaser will adjust for any arithmetical errors as follows:
 - (a) Where there is a discrepancy between amounts in figures and in words, the amount in words will govern;
 - (b) where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the line-item total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern.
 - iv. VALIDITY OF THE OFFER: Your bid should be valid for a period of sixty (60) days from the deadline for receipt of bid.
 - v. AWARD OF PURCHASE ORDER. The award will be made to the substantially responsive bidder offering the lowest evaluated price by issuing Purchase Order.
 - vi. PERFORMANCE SECURITY:
 - (a) Within seven (07) days of issuance of Purchase Order from the Purchaser, the successful bidder shall furnish the performance security in Pak Rupees to the amount of ten (10%) of contract price in shape of CDR/Bank Guarantee on a format as prescribed by the purchaser, at the option of bidder, in the name of CEO TransPeshawar from schedule bank of Pakistan. Performance Security shall remain valid thorough out execution of the contract and will be released after completion of the contract including warranty obligations and subject to satisfactory performance.
 - (b) The performance security may be forfeited fully or partially if the Supplier defaults under the contract.
 - (c) Failure of the successful bidder to submit the requisite performance security or to sign the contract agreement shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security. In that event, the Purchaser may award the contract to the next lowest evaluated bidder whose offer is substantially responsive.
 - vii. Signing of Contract: Within seven (07) days of issuance of the Purchase Order, the successful bidder will sign the contract agreement with the purchaser.
 - viii. Purchaser's Right to Accept Any Bid, and to Reject Any or All Bids: The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to bidders.

FORM OF CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT number **TPC/IT/OCB/G/2024-25/002** made on -----, **2025**, between Chief Executive Officer TransPeshawar (The Urban Mobility Company) (hereinafter called "the Purchaser") on the one part and ----- (hereinafter called "the Supplier") on the other part.

WHEREAS the Purchaser has requested bids for **Supply, Delivery and Installation of Interactive Flat Panel to TransPeshawar**, to be provided by Supplier, viz. Contract **Supply, Delivery and Installation of Interactive Flat Panel to TransPeshawar**, (hereinafter called "the Contract") and has accepted the bid by the Supplier for the supply of goods under the Contract at a sum of (Amount in words and figures) hereinafter called "the Contract Price".

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this agreement, viz:
 - a) Form of Contract, Purchase Order, Form of Bid, Bid, Terms and Conditions of Supply, Technical Specifications and standard of performance (Appendix-I), Performance Security.
 - b) Addendum (if applicable);
2. Taking into account payments to be made by the Purchaser to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby concludes an Agreement with the Purchaser to execute and complete the supply, delivery, and installation of goods under the Contract and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provisions of the Contract.
3. The Purchaser hereby covenants to pay, in consideration of the acceptance of Contract, supply, delivery, and installation of the goods and remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price in accordance with Payment Conditions prescribed by the Contract.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY

Purchaser: TransPeshawar (The Urban Mobility Company)

1. Schedules for Supply, Delivery and Installation:

2. Fixed Price: The price indicated in the Form of Bid shall be firm and fixed and not subject to any adjustment during performance of the contract.
3. Delivery: The Supplier shall complete the delivery within above stated duration at place of delivery.
5. Applicable Law: The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
6. Resolution of Disputes: The Purchaser and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute between them under or in connection with the Contract. In the case of a dispute between the Purchaser and the Supplier, the dispute shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration Act, 1940 of Pakistan.
7. Delivery and Documents: Upon delivery, the Supplier shall provide the following documents to the Purchaser:
- (i) copies of the Supplier's invoice showing goods' description, quantity, unit price, and total amount;
 - (ii) Delivery Challan/Note;
 - (iii) manufacturer's warranty certificate/Card.
8. Payment: Before payment, the Purchaser will inspect the delivered goods for meeting the quality and quantity against the prescribed specification and quantity. Any payment shall be processed after satisfactory assessment/inspection and acceptance by the Purchaser. Payment shall be made in following manner:
- a) 100% payment will be made after successful delivery, installation, acceptance of all goods and certificate of successful delivery by the purchaser at given site in accordance with the contract. The supplier shall present invoice along with copy of contract form and certificate of successful delivery for payment.
9. Performance Security: Within ten (10) days of the issuance of Purchase Order from the Purchaser, the successful bidder shall furnish the performance security in Pak Rupees to the amount of ten (10%) of contract price in shape of CDR/DD or Bank Guarantee on the format as prescribed by the purchaser, at the option of bidder, in the name of CEO TransPeshawar from schedule bank of Pakistan. Performance Security shall remain valid thorough out execution of the contract and will be released after completion of the contract including warranty obligations and subject to satisfactory performance. The performance security may be forfeited fully or partially if the Supplier defaults under the contract.
9. Warranty: Goods offered should be covered by manufacturer's warranty for at least 12 months from the date of delivery to the Purchaser. During the warranty period If the item is non repairable the supplier is bound to replace the item with new one.

The Supplier warrants that all the Goods are new, unused, and of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials, unless provided otherwise in the Contract.

The Supplier further warrants that the Goods shall be free from defects arising from any act or omission of the Supplier or arising from design, materials, and workmanship, under normal use in the conditions prevailing in the country.

10. Defects: All defects in Goods will be corrected/replaced without any cost to the Purchaser within 15 days during inspection and warranty period from the date of notice by the Purchaser. The name and address of service facility where the defects/defective item are to be corrected/replaced by the supplier are:

11. Force Majeure: The supplier shall not be liable for penalties or termination for default if and to the extent that it's delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.

For purposes of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but not restricted to, act of Purchaser in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.

If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Purchaser in writing, the Supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by Force Majeure event.

12. Required Technical Specifications:

The Technical Specifications and standard for performance are attached as **Appendix-I** to this Bid Solicitation Document. Suppliers shall confirm the compliance with the mentioned specifications of goods.

13. Failure to Perform: The Purchaser may cancel the Agreement and proceed for other remedy provided under the contract or other relevant law if the Supplier fails to supply and deliver the Goods, in accordance with the above terms and conditions.
